



# Safe Return to Play League Representative Guidelines

The Sport & Social Club (SSC) is committed to the highest levels of safety for our community of League Representatives (GC/ELF/Instructor/Staff). In order to work with SSC and stay in good standing, the following guidelines **MUST** be followed for the protection of us all.

*Government and public health authorities may issue stronger public health orders and guidelines which will override these guidelines.*

## Keeping YOU safe



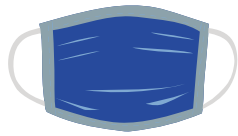
**Seasonal Training** and SSC's COVID-19 Safety Policy Review will be mandatory and provided virtually via Zoom.



League Representatives must **practice good hygiene**. Wash your hands with soap & water and/or hand sanitizer before, during and after your shift. Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.



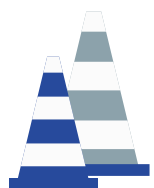
If you feel sick or have been in close contact with someone who is sick, **you must stay home**.



Players, spectators and SSC league representatives must follow provincial mask mandates and/or facility-level mask protocols when attending SSC activities.



League Representatives **must bring the provided SSC Sanitation Kit to every shift** and set it up ahead of player arrival. This kit is for League Representative use only.



League Representatives are required to **report any COVID-19 regulation infractions** (teams not abiding) to the SSC Head Office within 12 hours of the game.



Provincial Health Orders and/or facility regulations regarding **proof of vaccination status must be followed by all players (where applicable)**.

## Keeping PLAYERS safe

All League Representatives **must enforce** the procedures and sport regulations as outlined on the SSC website. This includes Self-Screening, League Modifications, Player Guidelines and updated Sport Rules.

Teams must arrive on time and depart games / facility area immediately upon completion.

League Representatives are required to have the SSC **Sanitation Kit set up on a table** or in a designated spot ahead of all games. This kit is for use by League Representatives only.

Never provide teams with your Rules Handbook, GC Manual or Cell Phone. If a schedule or rule needs to be clarified, look yourself and provide the answer.

There will be **minimal rental equipment provided** at this time. Teams are required to bring their own sports equipment. Do not lend out equipment unless specified by SSC.

League Representatives are required to ensure players are maintaining a **2 meter distance** when arriving on-site, resting/sitting on the sidelines, and departing the games. **Limit use of team benches** where distancing measures cannot be accommodated.

Ensure teams do not enter a playing space until the previous players have cleared the area OR until you have signaled for the next team to enter.



## Other Rules & Regs



- If you are required to self-isolate based on provincial COVID-19 regulations, do not come to your shift.
- If you cannot make a shift, provide the SSC Sport Manager with as much notice as possible and find a substitute League Representative.
- League Representatives are NOT permitted to play in our leagues during their shift.
- All equipment the League Representative carries, MUST be properly disinfected before and after each shift.
- Everyone must cover their mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- At the end of the game, leave absolutely nothing on-site and ensure all garbage is placed into bins.
- COVID-19 Release: All League Representatives must have signed the updated waiver (including COVID-19 Release) before their first shift.



## The SSC Sanitation Kit

- Hand Sanitizer (80% alcohol +)
- Spray equipment/surface sanitizer
- Bucket for cleaning
- Cloths for cleaning
- Laminated Enter & Exit signs & clips
- Facility Map (where to place table)
- Facility Map (Enter/Exit signage)
